

# The audkcolors package

The `audkcolors` package defines the colors used in various designs at Aarhus University. Most colors are taken from *Colours (2024)*, though the the adjusted colors used in PowerPoint are not available online.

Note that we only define the RGB colors. *Colours 2024* also contains CMYK values, but CMYK colors does not always look right in L<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X, presumably because to get things right you also need colorspace specification what we do not have at this point.

## Standard colors

These are the colors defined in the URL mentioned above.

These come in combinations of a foreground (text) and a background color.

FG: AUPPFGturquoise		BG: AUPPBGturquoise

FG: AUPPFGred		BG: AUPPBGred

## Installation

The easiest way to use `audkcolors.sty` is to place it in the same folder as the main document of your project. No extra installation required.

If you want to install the package globally, follow a similar procedure as the one described in the manual for `audkfonts`.
